You have recently participated in the BLANKET TESTING event for the World Wrestling Entertainment, Inc. 2006 Substance Abuse and Testing Policy (the Policy). The results of the testing conducted on a sample collected from you on March 20, 2006 indicate you are NON-COMPLIANT with the requirements of the program and your test results are "positive". Forensic testing results have identified the presence of Hydrocodone in your sample which is a prohibited Narcotic Analgesic. Test results report Ephedrine which is a prohibited Stimulant. Test results also report Nandrolone in your sample which is a prohibited Androgenic Anabolic Steroid. These drugs are prohibited by the Policy unless you have an acceptable medical condition diagnosed by an appropriate physician specialist. Please be advised there are very few accepted medical conditions that will justify your use of the controlled medications/drugs detected. A future positive test result will require a medical consult with your physician to verify the prescription and purpose for use. Please remember that the Policy prohibits prescription fulfillment by Internet Pharmacies or the associated internet "diagnosis" by a "physician".

This positive test result has no punitive action. However, the data may be used as a baseline test for future test interpretation especially with reference to testing for Androgenic Anabolic Steroids and Polypeptide Hormones.
